- 4- Provide a mental health worker to help students who are struggling with mental health issues (\$12,500)
- 5- Provide substitutes for two department development days. Teachers will meet as departments to work on curriculum and school development (\$10,000).
- 6- Provide webcam (45) for each teacher (\$900)
- 7- Provide 15 microscopes for the science department (\$3,000)

- 4- Purchase Panorama license to support monitoring of academics, attendance, behavior and social-emotional issues (\$4,000)
- 5- Working lunch buyout for teacher to help students during the lunches (\$10,000)
- 6- Teacher material and supplies as needed (\$10,000)
- 7- Teacher "Tech Support" buyout (\$10,000)
